ABOUT THE ROLE

The Regional District of Nanaimo is seeking a temporary full-time Mechanic in the Transportation and Emergency Services Department.

The successful candidate will be responsible for vehicle and equipment repairs, including diagnosis and road testing, responding to roads calls for breakdowns or accidents, and the maintenance of records related to those repairs and servicing. Duties also include welding and fabricating, performing building maintenance and repairs, winterizing equipment such as towing and snow removal equipment, training of new staff, and other related duties, as required.

QUALIFICATIONS

Applicants must possess a high school diploma, plus a trade's qualification in heavy duty mechanics, and over five (5) years prior job-related experience, or an equivalent combination of training and experience. A working knowledge of WHMIS and Survival First Aid courses, good working knowledge of hydraulics, mobile equipment, standard bus electrical systems, air conditioning and multiplex wiring systems, as well as knowledge of safe and proper operation of equipment and work procedures is also required. Familiarization with wheelchair lift/ramp and restraint system vehicles would also be an asset. The incumbent must possess excellent communications skills with the ability to work under stress and make quick judgement calls. In addition, the incumbent must possess a valid Class 2 BC Driver's License with Air Brake Endorsement.

JOB SUMMARY

The Mechanic contributes to the effective operation of the Transportation Services Department through the diagnosis, repair and modification of vehicles and equipment. This position supports the Transportation Services Department by assisting team members in their duties, as required, to meet service expectations, departmental goals and objectives.

PRIMARY DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Assists in the inspection of equipment and arranges for necessary repairs.
- Performs equipment repairs including diagnosis and road testing.
- Maintains records, schedules and reports for all servicing and repairs.
- Inspects and orders supplies as required
- Purchases goods and issues purchase orders as necessary.
- Welds and fabricates building, plant or equipment modifications, as required.
- Performs building maintenance and repairs.
- Performs clean up duties.
- Responds to road calls for breakdowns or accidents, travels to site ensuring proper tools are brought, as required.
- Winterizes equipment such as towing and snow removal equipment.
- Assists in the training of new staff on mechanical aspects of busses (i.e. fluid level checking, and electronic fault codes) as required.
- Performs other related duties, as required.
